Federcalcio Servizi relaunches the Sports Green project at Myplant & Garden: sports facilities towards integrated sustainability

Even for the 2026 edition, on the central day of the fair, February 19, institutional meetings, workshops and seminars are scheduled

Rome-IT, July 2025 – **Federcalcio Servizi** is company wholly owned (100%) by the **Italian Football Federation** (FIGC), it is responsible for the management of the federal real estate assets, with a particular focus on infrastructures dedicated to football.

Federcalcio Servizi renews its partnership with Myplant & Garden, the leading Green fair, also for the 2026 edition (February 18-20, Fiera Milano Rho), with the aim of consolidating and expanding the "**Verde Sportivo-My Green Sports**" project. This is a strategic initiative aimed at promoting sustainable sports facilities.

The Pavilion dedicated to the "**Verde Sportivo-My Green Sports**", already a benchmark for sustainable infrastructure, will become, starting in 2026, **a true operational laboratory**. In this context, institutional actors, stakeholders and professionals will be able to interact and experiment with new solutions, thus accelerating the adoption of innovative and sustainable standards.

The partnership, focused precisely on the innovation of sports facilities, aims to optimize guidelines for high-performance, sustainable and socially responsible infrastructures.

The claim of the 2026 edition of Myplant, "**Green is More**", perfectly summarizes the philosophy of this synergy, which aims to transform sports flooring from a functional element to the **engine of an integrated sustainable system**.

"I believe that everyone, regardless of the field in which they operate – states Mauro Grimaldi, CEO of Federcalcio Servizi – must take an active role in reducing environmental impact, optimizing water resources and promoting inclusiveness. A sports facility today must generate tangible value for the territory: from emissions reduction to accessibility for athletes and the community."

The renewal is also based on the outstanding results of the 2025 edition: 27,000 attendees (+10% over 2024), 810 exhibitors from 40 countries and an international audience that has established Myplant & Garden as a hub for innovation in technical-sports greenery.

"These numbers show that the sector demands a change that keeps pace with the times – says Valeria Randazzo, Head of Myplant & Garden – The fair responds to this need, leading the transition towards facilities that combine technology, ecology and social well-being."

The 2026 edition will become the international laboratory where it will be possible to experience firsthand the solutions for sustainable sports centers, public parks and athletic areas. "Our fair will be the meeting point between the global supply chain and best practices – concludes Randazzo. In collaboration with Federcalcio Servizi, we will promote a replicable model."
