Big Green Bang: Enter the Green Universe at Myplant & Garden 2025

- Hall 12: Innovative and sustainable products, including greenhouses, water management systems, soil-less cultivation, indoor farms, lighting solutions, and biocontrols.
- Hall 8: The Décor District, featuring freshly cut flowers, foliage, and home décor items, as well as the exciting Wedding Flowers Pavilion.

Spotlight on Wedding Flowers

The Wedding Flowers Pavilion is a collaboration between Myplant & Garden, *White Sposa* magazine, Floweracademy.it, Dini Holtrop, and AIPH Affiliate members MPS Certification, and Chrysal International. This initiative celebrates the artistry and sustainability of wedding floristry.

Attendees can enjoy spectacular floral displays, catwalks, and immersive wedding-themed settings. Industry operators—from growers to distributors, wedding planners, and venue managers—will connect during this segment, which also features an international conference on sustainably grown wedding flowers.
