# Myplant & Garden Award winners

During the Myplant & Garden fair that took place last week, from February 22-24, 2017 in Milan, six companies with innovative products/ideas received an award. Below, we listed the awarded companies.



### New varieties of ornamental plants

The Italian Paganopiante Azienda Floricola won the first prize in the category New varieties of ornamental plants with their Sanseveria Cylindrica Budda Hand. This plant has thicker and more resistant leaves, compact form, and the shape of the leaves makes it more interesting from an ornamental point of view.



### New varieties of cut flowers

In the category New varieties of cut flowers the Lysianthus Eustoma Arena of Italian grower Gambin Floricoltura won first prize. The intensity of colour and size of flowers was praised by the jury.



New plants and flowers assortment with peculiar ecologic, environmental and/or fair trade significance

The orchids without pesticides of Dutch grower Stolk Flora won first prize in the category New assortments and commercial preparations of ornamental plants and flowers with a peculiar ecologic, environmental and/or fair trade significance. It is a certified variety of orchids from environmental friendly agriculture.



## Innovative means of production

In the Innovative means of production category, the Odrip-reserve of Italian Ajs won the first prize. It is a mono plant drop sprinkler with water reserve, also for non-professional use. It also works on low pressure.



## Innovative machinery and tools for production

In the Innovative machinery and tools for production category, Italian Omnigreen 365 won the first prize with: It Selling Solutions. It is characterised by the integration of several remote control systems for the management of irrigation systems. It has also an alert system in case of malfunction, damage etc.



New building materials and/or furniture for garden and landscape

In the category New building materials and/or furniture for garden and landscape, the geofilter system of IPM Italia won the first prize. It is a permeable, filtering and environmental friendly paving system that keeps the characteristics of the environment intact without the need of storage tanks.
