How was the 7th edition of the Myplant & Garden?

As said, the number of visitors has been the highest in the show's history. In total, 23,000 visitors came to the Myplant & Garden, which hosted 654 exhibitors, 21% of which were from abroad. The majority of the companies exhibiting came from the Italian regions of Lombardy, Veneto, and Tuscany.

One hundred eighty delegations of buyers were at the fair from 5 continents and 40 countries and 300 journalists, of which our FloralDaily reporter was one. When talking to the exhibitors, they were pleased with the quality and quantity of the visitors, and some found the level of international visitors higher than in previous years.

Next year, 2024, the show will take place from February 21-23.
